You are paying for their services as part of your property taxes. Their function is to assist you in the planning and construction of terracing on your property to support water and soil conservation. In this, they will analyze your property and recommend appropriate terracing, tree and vegetation planting and mulch distribution to prevent soil erosion and maximize the use of rainwater. They may pay for part of the material and labor costs. In addition, they are a great source of native grass seed mixes.
  
- **SMR Road Maintenance – Bernalillo County is responsible for maintaining SMR roads (which are county roads).**
  
- **Snow Removal**
  - I-40, Highway 217 and Rt. 66, the State and County remove snow within 24 hours.
  - Sandia Mountain Ranch Roads – The County plows our roads usually within 24 hours because we are on a school bus route. It may not be plowed for 48 hours if the snow is 24” deep or more because it takes them longer to plow the main thoroughfares.
