

The SMRNA Web Site

The SMRNA (Sandia Mountain Ranch Neighborhood Association) web site is located at www.SMRNA.org. For those upwardly mobile users, you know who you are; you can go to www.SMRNA.org/Mobile for a version that is designed for the more small-screened users among us.

The web site provides a [Home Page](#) that provides basic information about SMR (Sandia Mountain Ranch) and SMRNA. A good deal of the web site is protected by a username and password to help protect the privacy of the information.

The links across the top of each page provide access to:

- [311](#) provides useful recommendations of on various subjects, which are consistently being added to. These items include Animal Sitters, Appliance Repair, Bear Issues, Concrete Work, Dentists, Drywall Repairs, Garage Door Repairs, Gardening Resources, House Cleaning, Landscaping, Mowing, Fire Information, Pet Care, Rain Barrels, Remodeling, Road Clearing and Conditions, School Information, Snakes, Snow Removal, Water Treatment and Window Washing.
- [Calendar](#) provides a chronological list of events that might be of interest to the SMR residents. Where additional information is available for a particular entry, there is usually a place to click on to get more information. If the event is taking place at a SMR residence, then a link is generally provided that will take you to that person's information in the directory. This way you can see the particulars about the host, including their address and telephone number.
- [Directory](#) is the link to the [SMR Directory](#) which provides all the useful information we come to expect from a detailed directory including the first and last names of all the residents and their offspring, telephone numbers (home, work and cell), pet and vehicle descriptions, & street and e-mail addresses. If after reviewing the [SMR Directory](#) you have updates to provide, please be sure and let David Smith know at Webmaster@SMRNA.org. There is also a link on the [Directory](#) page to download a [PDF version](#) of the most recent version of the [SMR Directory](#). You should notice in both the [on-line directory](#) and the [downloaded version](#) that the e-mail links are "hot", meaning that you can click on them to enter them into your e-mail client, all ready to send out that pressing e-mail. You should find that most of the web site provides these "clickable" links where appropriate.
- [Lists](#) provides descriptions and links to all the [SMR E-mail Lists](#). This includes links for sending out e-mails to all the residents in SMR (Neighbors@SMRNA.org), the members of the SMRNA (Members@SMRNA.org), Architectural Control Committee (ACC@SMRNA.org), to all the officers of the SMRNA (Directors@SMRNA.org), and the Neighborhood Watch Block Captains (NeighborhoodWatch@SMRNA.org), and the e-mail list for East Mountain Coalition Information (EMC@SMRNA.org).
- [Newsletters](#) provides a link to a list of all the downloadable SMRNA Newsletters and other newsletters from the East Mountain and Albuquerque Areas that have potential information for SMR residents.
- [Volunteers](#) is an unprotected link to all the [SMRNA Volunteers](#) so that outsiders (and insiders who have forgotten the password) will have access to the appropriate personnel within the SMRNA. This list is similar to the [SMR E-mail Lists](#), but with the e-mail addresses obfuscated (hidden from computer searching robots). It also provides links to all the [Activity Leaders](#) within SMRNA.

The links along the right side of each page provide additional information:

- [Documents](#) provides a link to all the available [SMRNA and SMR Documents and other useful tidbits](#): including the Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (CC&Rs) for the various phases within SMR, SMRNA Bylaws, and Newcomer Information; [Fire Awareness Documents](#) including: Forest Thinning, Firewise Communities, Be Firewise, East Mountain Community Wildfire Protection Plan, etc.; [Government Documents](#) including: Bernalillo County Documents, Forest Health Program, Fire Evacuation Plans, and Environmental Quality Profile; [Consumer Information](#) on: Hantavirus, Plaque, West Nile Virus, Consumer Action Handbook, and NM Geologic History; and [Outdoor Information](#): about Insects & Pests, Composting, and Forest Thinning.
- [Eateries](#) provides links and menus to some of the East Mountain Eateries. If you find a place that isn't included and should be, please let the David Smith know at Webmaster@SMRNA.org.

- [Financials](#) provides the financial information about SMRNA and agendas and minutes from the various meetings.
- [History](#) provides a summary history of SMR, this part of the web site is currently under construction.
- [Newcomers](#) provides links to the various items that make up the Newcomer's Packet that is distributed to all newcomers to SMR.
- [Notices](#) of very general information about SMR and the East Mountain Area.
- [Plat-Maps](#) of all the phases within SMR, this includes various identifying lot information.
- [Work-In-Progress \(WIP\)](#) displays a table presenting the current on-going projects within the boundaries of SMR.

Along the bottom of each SMRNA web page you will find links to all of the above referenced pages plus links to web pages that provide:

- [Help](#) using the SMRNA web site.
- [Links](#) to other useful web sites.
- [Location](#) provides directions and maps to SMR.
- [Mobile](#) provides a link to the Mobile version of the web site for those with smart phones, iPads or PDAs.
- [Privacy](#) addresses the issues with using the SMRNA web site, including the [SMRNA Web Site Mission](#), [Handling of Personal Information](#), [E-Commerce Web Site\(s\)](#), [Collecting Information on Minors](#), and [Web Linking Practices](#).
- [Shortcuts](#) that provide shorten links to various areas of the [SMRNA Web Site](#).
- [Site-Map](#) provides a list of all the web site pages and links to various areas on those web pages. This may allow an individual to more easily find information of a particular interest on the [SMRNA Web Site](#).
- [Summary](#) provides a summary link of all the "News" (information along the right side of many [SMRNA Web Site](#) pages).

Most of the web pages have links that allow you to load a printable version of the web page in your web browser or download a PDF version of the same web page, giving you various ways to visualize each web page.

Likewise, if English is not your first language, or you are otherwise English challenged, each of the main web pages provides a link towards the top to allow you to convert that page to the language of your choice. This is done using a Google Gadget; my French is pretty rusty, but it seems to do a reasonable job when, and if, needed.

All the web site pages show the date the last change was made to the page (towards the bottom) or the associated download (near the download). This can be useful in deciding, for instance, is it time to download an updated copy of the [SMR Directory](#)?
