SMRNA Web Site Mission

The mission of the SMRNA Web Site is to provide visitors to this web site with the most up-to-date information regarding SMRNA and present it in a manner best suited to their needs. The SMRNA Web Site may be accessed by all Internet users on a 24/7 (24 hours a day / 7 days a week) basis. The SMRNA Web Site is the most accurate source of information on SMRNA. Handling of Personal Information

SMRNA may request information from visitors if they choose to subscribe to e-mail lists, place orders or if they choose to respond to advertising or promotions. This personal information is necessary in order for SMRNA to fulfill the visitor's request.

E-Commerce Web Site(s)

 - One of the navigation links refers to a description of the company that sponsors the web site. It may be titled "About (Third Party's Name)."
 - A third party's privacy policy and terms of use statement are identified instead of SMRNA's.
 - Information in the footer at the bottom of the web site contains information about a company other than SMRNA.
